The Digital Accountability and Transparency Act of 2014, or the DATA Act, represents a historical move toward increased government openness and accountability. Many challenges stand in the way of DATA Act compliance, particularly in the area of federal grants issuance and management, including outdated legacy systems or the absence of an automated grants management process. Success will depend on the modernization and improvement of existing systems, or innovation and discipline applied to new systems, under development.
